



Lynne M. Murphy Performing Arts Scholarship

Purpose: To honor a graduating senior who has displayed excellence in the area of Performing Arts: Drama, Instrumental, Orchestral, or Vocal. One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1,500.

Eligibility:

- ❖ Applicant must have completed three years of high school at D'Evelyn.
- ❖ Applicant must demonstrate artistic excellence through their reference letters, scholarship application essays, awards received, test scores, papers or academic projects, or through other creative means.
- ❖ Applicant must plan to attend a four-year college after graduating from D'Evelyn. The scholarship award will be issued to the college of the student's choice and can be used for tuition, fees, or books.

Selection Criteria (in order of importance):

- ❖ Demonstrated artistic excellence
- ❖ Character
- ❖ Overall achievement

Submit the following:

- Submit the DEF Scholarship Application Form, resume, educational-goal essay and transcript
- Submit two letters of recommendation (at least one from a D'Evelyn faculty member)
- Answer the following scholarship-specific essay question** (500 to 1,000 words, on a separate sheet of paper): Please discuss how you have achieved excellence in the performing arts.

Optional: Submit any additional information that can help you demonstrate excellence (within reason – please respect the Selection Committee's time). This can include information about awards, test scores, papers or academic projects, or other materials.
